About Webinar Theme

Continuity and change are always reflected in the foreign policy of the nations and Indian foreign policy is no exception to it. Recently a few discernible dimensions have emerged in Indian foreign policy, such as- economic and technical developments having precedence now and both domestic and foreign policy have been oriented to achieve these aims. The trends like strengthening defence capability and using it as deterrence vis- a- vis hostile neighbours, realising the significance of soft power and public diplomacy including digital diplomacy and nation branding have been noticed. Relations with South East Asian nations have been made more vibrant by replacing the Look East policy with the Act East policy.

India has strongly dealt with Chinese incursions and Pakistan's misadventures on borders. Taking a dissenting note on the Trade Facilitation Agreement (TFA) in the WTO also shows the strong will to protect the national



interest. Evacuation and assistance to Indians living in conflict zone of Iraq, Libya, Ukraine and now in Afghanistan were no less a gigantic diplomatic endeavour. Prime Minister's visits to foreign countries were the attempts to connect with the India Diaspora there. India put forth a constructive approach at the forums of BRICS, SAARC and ASEAN.

On the second session of the virtual seminar Dr. Abhishek Shrivastav, Assistant Professor, Jawaharlal Nehru Univerisyt, was the Speaker of the Second Technical Session. Dr. Sharda Mahajan, Principal, N.M.D. College, Gondia was presided the the second technical session. On this Occasion, Dr. Abhishek Shrivastav said, Post-Independence foreign



policy can be considered in three segments – the first ending in 1964 with the death of Jawaharlal Nehru; the second from 1964 to 1989, being the periods of Indira Gandhi, the Janata interlude and Rajiv Garidhi; and the third, the post-1990 post-Cold War period, which still continues. There are, of course, considerable overlaps of these frameworks, but they represent successively the formulation, mutation and abandonment of non-alignment. In the first two segments, non-alignment was the leitmotif of Indian foreign policy. He said, Non-alignment's ideological moorings began, flourished and died with Nehru. The second period was one of realism and pragmatism that found India moving ever closer into the orbit of the Soviet Union. The present period after 1990 and the demise of the Soviet Union found India in an unfamiliar international environment, but it recovered to adjust to opportunism – in the sense of seeking and exploiting. Four research papers were presented by the Researcher. Dr. Mahajan Madam expresses here views on the research papers. Dr. Vaishali Meshram conducted the programme while Dr. Smita Samdekar, Assistant Professor proposed vote of thanks.

The Valedictory function of the Virtual Seminar was organized under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Dr. Sharda Mahajan, Princiapl, N.M.D. College, Gondia. She stated that Seminar is very fruitful for the college teachers, researcher and students and it was a grand success. 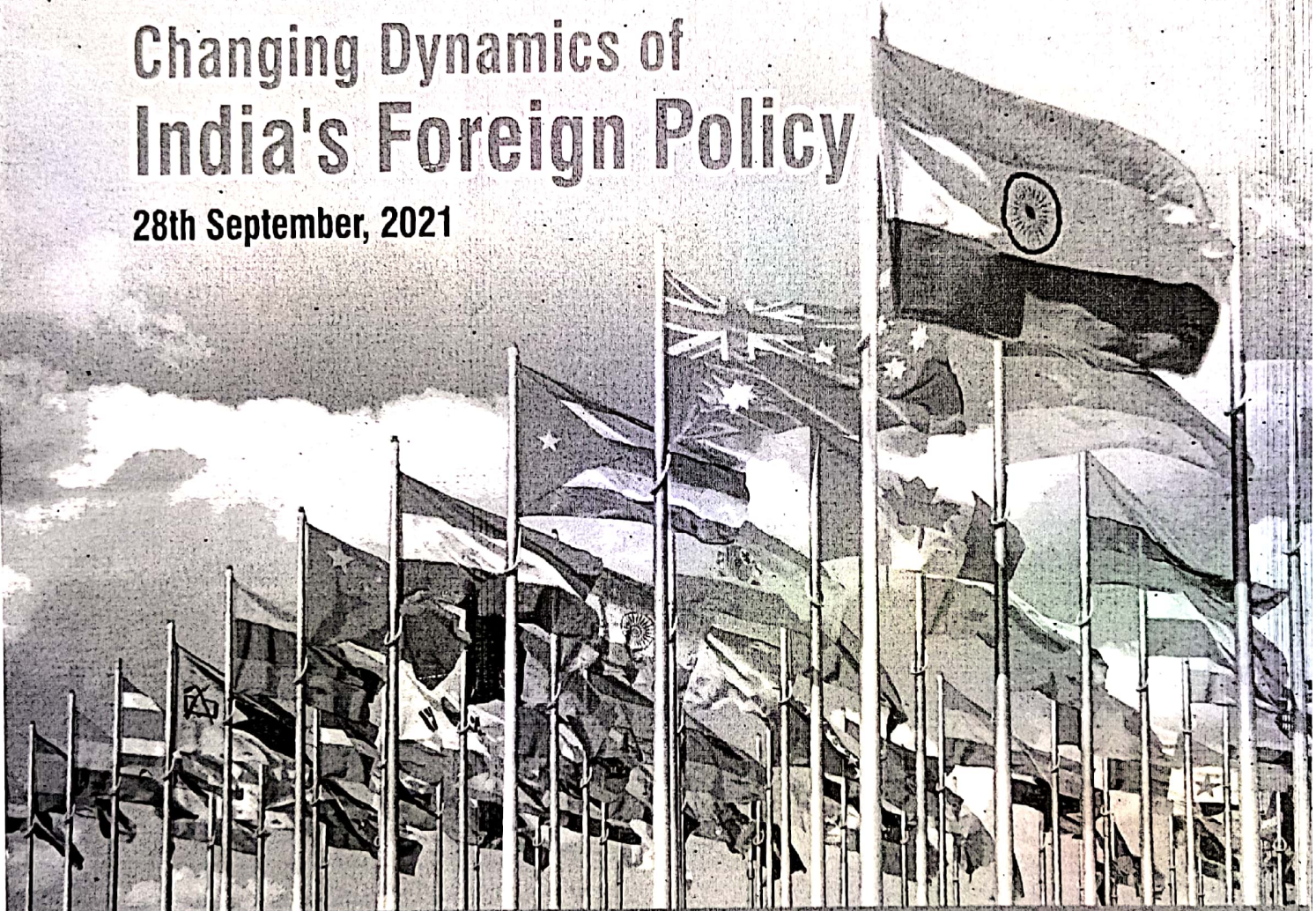

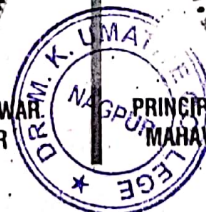
